



How to Avoid Accidents with Deer


Deer-related road accidents are on the rise throughout in Hokkaido, up to 2,010 accidents in 2015.




Number of Hokkaido Sika Deer Accidents per Year (Hokkaido)




Number of Hokkaido Sika Deer Accidents per Year (By Region)

An individual adult Hokkaido sika deer is comparable in size to a human or a passenger car. A collision could injure the occupants of the car!




Vehicle Repair Costs due to Hokkaido Sika Deer Accidents (Vehicle Insurance Payout Amount)

Understand the Behavior of Hokkaido Sika Deer to Stay Safe

Six Rules to Avoid Deer Collisions

Reduce Speed in any of these Situations

1 Deer often jump out at early morning or evening!




Deer are most active at sunrise and around sunset.

4 Deer are clumsy on paved roads!



The Hokkaido sika deer is known to be swift and graceful, but its movement is clumsy on paved roads. Even when cars approach, deer sometimes do not run away.

2 Deer are seldom alone!



Hokkaido sika deer behave in herds. After the first deer crosses a road, several more will often follow, sometimes suddenly jumping out.

5 Brake marks on mountain roads are signs of danger!



Black brake marks on the road may be a sign of deer activity. Take these as a warning, and lower your speed.

3 Shining spots at night mean danger!



The eyes of Hokkaido sika deer appear to glow as they reflect the light from vehicle headlights.

6 Keep an eye on roadside forests!



Hokkaido sika deer consider roads that pass through forests as just another part of their territory. Whenever you are near forests, be aware that deer could jump out at any time.


